We always need basic toiletries like soap, shampoo, deodorant and toothbrushes for our guests. Assembling hygiene kits is a meaningful way to provide homeless and hungry people a way to maintain their health and personal hygiene.

Here are three easy steps to donate hygiene packets to One80 Place:

1. Purchase or Collect the items:

Please include the five items listed below in every hygiene packet. You may also include additional items such as ponchos, washcloths, tissues, cotton swabs or hand sanitizer. We encourage you to help us by assembling 150-200 hygiene packets. Some groups have found it easiest to purchase these items from Amazon.com.

- travel size soap
- travel size shampoo
- toothbrush
- travel size toothpaste
- travel size deodorant

2. Assemble the items:

Once you have gathered your supplies, it is time to organize your hygiene kits. Group the items by product to make a simple assembly line. Put the hygiene items in a half-gallon Ziploc bag. Be sure that the caps are tight to prevent spilling when the hygiene kits are moved.
