Mr. Drayton called the meeting to order at 8:30 a.m. The minutes from the February 28, 2019 meeting were approved upon a motion and a second.

Ms. Denaux announced that Linda Jean will be retiring April 25th, and introduced Kaovaunte Legare as the future Office Manager. She also introduced Cherie Brown as the newly hired Finance Manager reporting to JR English.

Mr. Corona reported that Carnival Cruise Lines has chosen One80 Place as their charity to donate \$15,000. They will also be hosting a luncheon on May 18th and have provided us with 15 tickets. Mr. Drayton, Mr. Harvey, Ms. Wallace and Mr. Adams will be receiving tickets. The remainder of tickets will go to staff.

Ms. Wilson discussed Legal Services, SOAR and Homeless Court. In FY18, 661 clients were seen by our Legal Team. SOAR is SSI/SSDI Outreach, Access and Recovery. In FY18, our staff submitted 20 applications. We have an average date of decision of 78 days. The national average is 100.

Ms. Vosburgh discussed Homeless Court. Individuals with misdemeanor citations by the City of Charleston can be referred to Homeless Court. They are assigned to and work with a service provider. In court they tell the judge what things have been done to help end homelessness. Most individuals want a home of their own and work the program.

Ms. Wallace suggested adding the Homeless Court dates to the agenda under important dates.

Mr. Corona updated on the Welcome Home Campaign. We are at 76% of goal. Would like to be at 80% before going public. There are still about 90 more people that Ms. Denaux and Mr. Corona need to cultivate.

Ms. Denaux discussed the project progress. Still in the process of figuring how to cut \$3M from the project. Attended a successful meeting regarding storm water management. Currently we are at an actual cost of \$15.2M and the goal is to get down to \$14.7M. A discussion began among the members to try and get more money from the city from projects that may not happen
